	 \$50 deposit due by Friday 4th July - Shown in School Bytes portal as Aussie Bush Camp Deposit \$100 due by Friday 15 August - this amount will show in your School Bytes portal as \$93.50 for food and \$6.50 Aussie Bush Camp Payment 1 \$100 Due by Friday 26 September - Shown in School Bytes Portal as Aussie Bush Camp Payment 2 \$50 due by Friday 31 October - Shown in School Bytes Portal as Aussie Bush Camp Final Payment and not available for payment until 26th September.

If medical clearance is not provided, the student cannot participate in vigorous or competitive school sport or physical activities for 21 days from the concussion date.
