LUNCH PASSES YEARS 7 - 11

Lunch Passes are for students who live close to the school to go home and have lunch, supervised by a parent or parents. Exceptions are allowed where students go to their relatives homes.

Lunch Passes are granted at the Principal's discretion and are a privilege. They are not to be used for shopping, appointments or visiting friends. Students who regularly return to school late after lunch or don't use their pass correctly will have it withdrawn.

All students who need to go down the street or leave the school during the day can have short leave granted to them if they bring a note from their parent/caregiver, to the Deputy Principal **before school**.

Only students who live in the area bounded by Marquet Street, Flags Road, Gooch Street and MacKenzie Street will be granted a lunch pass. Parents who live outside this zone will need to discuss the matter with the Deputy Principal.
